### Background:

Staff will review the Commission legislative process, including regular conference calls during the legislative session to evaluate legislative proposals related to fish and wildlife management, Department administration, and other relevant items. Previously, calls have occurred on either Wednesday or Thursday mornings at 8 a.m. MST, and staff have provided the Commission with a summary of legislation and bill status. The weekly calls provide the Commission with the opportunity to determine whether a policy position is warranted.

Attached are sample forms that will be used to summarize and track legislation in addition to Commission positions.

The Department has no agency-sponsored legislation proposed for the 2025 Legislative Session.

### Statutory Authority and/or Policy Issues:

The Commission has responsibility to provide policy direction for Department-sponsored legislation and provide policy guidance relative to other legislative initiatives and process, including issues the Commission has worked with other stakeholders to advance.

### **Public Involvement Process:**

Commission quarterly meetings provide the public with comment opportunities regarding ideas for agency-sponsored legislation which follows a process and schedule determined by the Governor's office. The legislative process also provides the public a separate opportunity to comment to their elected representatives on the merits of legislation.

### Justification:

Define the Commission's legislative process to facilitate timely and effective policy input during the 2025 legislative session.

### **Staff Recommendation:**

Continue a process similar to what was conducted in previous years that evaluates legislative proposals as directed by the Commission, including establishing the 2025 teleconference calendar (e.g., day of week, time of conference call, frequency of calls).
