The videos listed in this appendix are the only authorized videos available for use with the Hunter Education Course Curriculum. DVDs marked with (CC) are available in a closed captioned version for the hearing impaired students. They must be specifically requested from Regional Hunter Education Techs or from the Hunter Education Distribution Center. Videos with the symbol ** are produced by IDFG and available on a “4 in 1” DVD.

Hunter Education Course Videos / DVDs

ETHICS and RESPONSIBILITY

Beyond Fair Chase (BFC)

A good ethics video. Discusses the benefits of conservation, our hunting heritage and the past role of hunting, respect for wildlife and land, and accepting responsibility for ethical hunting. A teenager comments on the value of ethical hunting. (13 Minutes) (VHS or DVD)

Care / Share (CS) **

Focuses on Idaho landowner and guest relationships. Discusses hunting ethics regarding fences, trespass concerns, gate open/close courtesy, and other rangeland issues. Produced jointly by IDFG and the ID Rangeland Commission. (8 Minutes) (VHS or DVD)

OHV – Trails – Hunting (OTH) **

Provides tips for OHV/ATV riders while hunting. An IDFG conservation officer discusses how to find out where to ride during hunting season, special rules and trail riding etiquette for hunters. (6.5 Minutes) (DVD)

The Hunter’s Path (HP)

Illustrates choices in responsible hunting, hunter and landowner relations and public image. Provides a series of thought provoking dilemmas for discussion. (18 Minutes) (DVD) (CC)

The Measure of the Hunt (MOTH)

Presents four dilemma scenarios focused on hunting on posted property, disregard for game laws, over-eagerness to bag game, and the hunter’s image to the non-hunting public. (29 Minutes) (VHS only)

HUNTER SAFETY

Firearms Safety and the Hunter (FSTH)

Through the use scenarios video depicts the causes for most hunting accidents – victim mistaken for game, victim out-of-sight of shooter, shooting outside zone of fire, gun mishandling and poor judgment. (22 Minutes) (VHS or DVD)

Shattered Lives (SL) **

Dramatically reviews the circumstances involved the 1999 tragic fatal hunting accident that involved 2 adult hunters in North Idaho. Includes emotional commentaries by shooter and victim’s family. Produced by IDFG. (15 Minutes) (VHS or DVD) (CC)

Shoot / Don’t Shoot II (SDS)

A safety training film, which depicts ten realistic hunting situations leading to the moment when a shot can be fired. Interactive -- viewers determine if it is a safe shot or not. The proper answer is then graphically demonstrated. (15 minutes) (VHS or DVD) (CC)

The Last Shot (LS)

Dramatically depicts a fatal shooting resulting from careless gun handling involving two teenage boys. Comes with instructor’s guide for use. (15 Minutes) (VHS or DVD) (CC)

OUTDOOR SAFETY

Survival! (S)

Uses four separate scenarios of actual wilderness emergency case histories to teach survival techniques. Covers most common outdoor emergencies – hypothermia, weather related accidents, dehydration, disorientation, and panic. (22 Minutes) (VHS or DVD) (CC)

Survival and Outdoor Safety - Beyond The 10 Essentials (SOS)

Covers how to survive the crucial first 48 hours out in the wilderness and many new survival techniques. Hands-on instruction on how to create some amazing survival shelters with materials that will fit in your back pocket, start fires successfully when weather conditions are at their absolute worst, make drinkable water in the desert without working up a sweat, use surgical tubing to make some ingenious hunting devices, the most effective signaling device, and much more. (35 Minutes) (DVD only)

WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT, CONSERVATION AND IDENTIFICATION

Wildlife Identification (WLID)

Covers many species of North American big game, small game, waterfowl and upland birds. (12 Minutes) (VHS only).

Wolves in Idaho (WI) **

Discusses background and history of wolves in Idaho, wolf identification and precautions to take when outdoors in wolf country. Produced by IDFG. (8 Minutes) (VHS or DVD) (CC)

Safe Treestand Hunting Strategies (STHS)

Provides the most updated treestand safety and use information. Also gives tips and techniques on how every hunter can become more responsible in the field while using tree stands. NBEF approved version. (25 Minute - Classroom Version) (DVD only)
