

## **The NW Fish Culture Conference Technician and Student Scholarships**

The Oregon Chapter of the American Fisheries Society is encouraging hatchery managers and instructors to nominate hatchery technicians and students in an aquaculture program for a scholarship to attend the 2013 Northwest Fish Culture Conference, in **Boise Idaho, December 3 – 5, 2013** (<http://fishandgame.idaho.gov/public/fish/?getPage=297>).

### **Two \$500 scholarships available to Oregon hatchery technicians and students:**

There are two \$500 scholarships available — one for a non-student hatchery technician, and one for a student in an aquaculture-related program. They can be used for any costs related to the conference (registration, travel, lodging, etc.).

### **One \$500 scholarship available to any Northwest aquaculture student:**

There is one \$500 scholarship due to extra funds leftover from the 2012 NWFCC meeting along with a small amount added from OR-AFS chapter. This award can be used for any costs related to the conference (registration, travel, lodging, etc.).

### **Nominations should include:**

1. Name and contact information of the nominee and nominator
2. AFS membership number of nominee (if a member)
3. Brief description of the nominee's recent school and/or work experience
4. Expected career benefits from attending the NWFCC

Nominations will be evaluated by the OR-AFS Fish Culture Committee and ExCom, and preference may be given to AFS members.

Recipients will be notified via email by Nov. 08, 2013.

Winners are encouraged to submit a summary of their trip to the Piscatorial Press (OR-AFS newsletter), and also to attend the OR Chapter AFS Annual Meeting February 25-28, 2014, in Eugene, OR.
