IDAHO CODE 36-405(c)(2), Application for license  
-- Duplicate license -- Unlawful purchase, possession,  
and use of license  
2. No person shall:  
(A) Acquire more than one (1) regular controlled hunt  
permit per species or more tags per species than the  
commission has set a bag limit for that species except  
as provided in subsection (b) of this section or to have  
said permits or tags in his possession.  
(B) Transfer any fishing, hunting, or trapping license  
to any other person or for any person to make use  
of such license issued to any other person with the  
exception of a parent or grandparent designating any  
controlled hunt tag or controlled hunt permit to his or  
her minor child or grandchild as prescribed by rules  
of the commission. A controlled hunt tag or controlled  
hunt permit can be designated only to a minor child  
with a valid hunting license or one who is participating  
in a mentored hunting program as prescribed by rules  
of the commission. A controlled hunt tag or controlled  
hunt permit designated to a minor child cannot be  
sold.

IDAPA 13.01.08.260.01.h and i, Use of Control Hunt  
Tags  
h. Any resident adult person who possesses any  
controlled hunt tag may designate the controlled hunt  
tag to their resident child or grandchild under the age  
of eighteen (18) who is qualified to participate in the  
hunt.  
i. Rules for use of controlled hunt tags  
in Sections 260 and 261 and rules for eligibility in  
Subsection 260.03 apply to any resident adult person  
who possesses and designates a control hunt tag to  
their resident child or grandchild. Mandatory school  
as provided in Section 270 shall apply to the designated  
resident child or grandchild.  
ii. Designation of the controlled hunt tag  
shall be made on a form prescribed by the Department  
and may be submitted either in person to any Idaho  
Department of Fish and Game Office or by mail to the  
License Supervisor at P.O. Box 25, Boise, ID 83707.  
iii. Any resident child or grandchild cannot  
be designated more than one control hunt tag per  
species per calendar year.

iv. Designation of a controlled hunt tag shall be completed before the first opening hunt date for the tag.

i. Any nonresident adult person who possesses any controlled hunt tag may designate the controlled hunt tag to their nonresident child or grandchild under the age of eighteen (18) who is qualified to participate in the hunt.

i. Rules for use of controlled hunt tags in Sections 260 and 261 and rules for eligibility in Subsection 260.03 apply to any nonresident adult person who possesses and designates a control hunt tag to their nonresident child or grandchild. Mandatory school as provided in Section 270 shall apply to the designated nonresident child or grandchild.

ii. Designation of the controlled hunt tag shall be made on a form prescribed by the Department and may be submitted either in person to any Idaho Department of Fish and Game Office or by mail to the License Supervisor at P.O. Box 25, Boise, ID 83707.

iii. Any nonresident child or grandchild cannot be designated more than one control hunt tag per species per calendar year.

iv. Designation of a controlled hunt tag shall be completed before the first opening hunt date for the tag.

#### IDAPA 13.01.08.260.06 Refunds of Control Hunt Fees

a. Controlled hunt tag fees will be refunded to the unsuccessful or ineligible applicants for moose, sheep, and mountain goat. Unsuccessful applicants may donate all or a portion of their tag fee for moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goat to Citizens Against Poaching by checking the appropriate box on the application. One dollar (\$1) of the non-refundable application fee will go to Citizens Against Poaching unless the applicant instructs otherwise.

b. Fees for hunting licenses will NOT be refunded to unsuccessful or ineligible applicants.

c. Fees for deer or elk tags purchased prior to the drawing will NOT be refunded to unsuccessful or ineligible applicants.

d. Overpayment of fees of more than five dollars (\$5) will be refunded. Overpayment of five dollars (\$5) or less will NOT be refunded and will be retained by the Department.

e. Application fees are nonrefundable.

f. Fees for resident and nonresident adult control hunt tags that are subsequently designated to their minor child or grandchild are not refundable.

#### IDAPA 13.01.09.100.03.k and l, Game Birds Tags, Stamps, Permits, and Validations.

k. Any resident adult person who possesses a controlled hunt permit may designate the controlled hunt permit to their resident child or grandchild under the age of eighteen (18) who is qualified to participate in the hunt. The designated child or grandchild shall possess a valid tag for the hunt.

i. Designation of the controlled hunt permit shall be made on a form prescribed by the Department and may be submitted either in person to any Idaho Department of Fish and Game Office or by mail to the License Supervisor at P.O. Box 25, Boise, ID 83707.

ii. Any resident child or grandchild cannot be designated more than one controlled hunt permit per calendar year.

iii. Designation of a controlled hunt permit shall be completed before the first opening hunt date for the permit.

l. Any nonresident adult person who possesses a controlled hunt permit may designate the controlled hunt permit to their nonresident child or grandchild under the age of eighteen (18) who is qualified to participate in the hunt. The designated child or grandchild shall possess a valid tag for the hunt.

i. Designation of the controlled hunt tag shall be made on a form prescribed by the Department and may be submitted either in person to any Idaho Department of Fish and Game Office or by mail to the License Supervisor at P.O. Box 25, Boise, ID 83707,

ii. Any nonresident child or grandchild cannot be designated more than one controlled hunt permit per calendar year.

iii. Designation of a controlled hunt permit shall be completed before the first opening hunt date for the permit.
