Idaho Fish & Wildlife Foundation Update

1. The IFWF Competitive Grant cycle opened February 1st and will close on April 30th; awards will be announced after the August board meeting.

2. Idaho Wildlife Plate program

The wildlife license plates continue to see growth year after year, especially with renewals. Total sales (new and renewal) from 2023-2024 increased by 6,698. All plates (new and renewal) showed growth in 2024.

New Sales 2023-2024

Bluebird 5,649, 7.64% increase from 2023 Elk 8,854, 6.89% increase from 2023 Trout 5,219, 5.73% increase from 2023

Overall new total 6.79% increase from 2023

Renewals 2023-2024

Bluebird 21,086, 7.10% increase over 2023 Elk 34,110, 7.50% increase over 2023 Trout 18,426, 9.93% increase over 2023

Overall renewal total 7.98% increase over 2023.
