

The Goal

The goal of *Access Yes!* is to provide hunting and fishing access on private land or through private land to public land in Idaho for current and future generations of sportsmen.

Landowner Participation

- **Step 1.** Voluntary enrollment of the property to be considered for the *Access Yes!* program. An enrollment form (available at the regional offices or on the Idaho Fish and Game's website) can be completed with the assistance of the regional landowner/sportsmen coordinator and submitted through the regional Idaho Fish and Game office.
- **Step 2.** The landowner submits a "bid" to the regional landowner/sportsmen coordinator which describes the property including location, land use, hunting and/or fishing resources available, landowner's terms of access to be allowed, and the type and amount of compensation.
- **Step 3.** "Bids" are reviewed by a local sportsman's review committee who evaluate the landowner's bid on criteria such as size of the parcel offered, type of access provided, type and abundance of game, quality of habitat, and bid price. These regional committees recommend which bids Idaho Fish and Game should accept.
- Step 4. Landowner notified of decision.

Landowners are compensated for enrolling their private land in the *Access Yes!* program by:

- 1. Direct monetary payments,
- 2. Habitat improvement or access development projects, or
- 3. Other incentives will be considered.

Regional Sportsman's Review Committee

Each sportsman's review committee is comprised of five local members with diverse sporting interests including big game, waterfowl and upland birds, angling, and trapping. They are nominated by the Idaho Fish and Game regional supervisor, approved by the Idaho Fish and Game director and serve two to three-year terms. Committee members cannot be enrolled in the *Access Yes!* program.

Limitation of Landowner Liability

Landowners participating in the *Access Yes!* program are covered by the state recreational liability statute (36-1604), which provides a liability shield to landowners who allow recreation on their property. The liability shield applies to landowners who provide recreational opportunities without charge or have entered into a cooperative lease agreement with the state.

Access Yes! Properties

In addition to this atlas, a guide to participating properties is available on the Fish and Game website at idfg.idaho.gov and at IDFG regional offices. The guide is updated each spring and provides the location and the recreational opportunities available. Properties are identified with unique signs featuring the *Access Yes!* logo.

How To Use This Guide

This guide begins with an overview of the *Access Yes!* properties in the Southeast Region, Upper Snake & Salmon Regions and continues to give you more detailed maps as you narrow down the areas you wish to access. The following steps will help you in this process:

- 1. Review the maps on pages 4-6 showing all of the *Access Yes!* properties and the game management units within the Southeast Region, Upper Snake & Salmon Regions.
- 2. Choose a game management unit you want more information about (Example: Unit 72).
- 3. Use the table of contents to find the page number where more information can be obtained for the game management unit you chose (Example: Unit 72 is found on page 55).
- 4. Review the map for the game management unit you chose and find a property (indicated by numbers in the bubbles) you want to access (Example: 58).
- 5. Use the number from the game management unit map identifying the property you want to access and find that number in the table on the following page.
- 6. Take note of the dates of access, activities allowed (e.g., big game hunting, trapping, fishing, etc.), and other restrictions (Example: 58 represents the property Chesterfield. The property can be accessed 10/1-11/30. Campfires and camping are prohibited. No vehicle use: walk-in or horse access only. Big game hunting and fishing is allowed).
- 7. The number used to identify the property also represents the page number where you can find a more detailed map of the property. Turn to that page.

Established Roadway Definition

An established roadway is defined as any road that is established, built, maintained, approved or designated by any government entity or private landowner for the purpose of travel by full-sized automobiles. An established roadway shows evidence of repeated use by full-sized automobiles, and may include a traveled way of natural earth with depressed wheel tracks and little or no vegetation in the tracks.

Access Point #1: Travel on Sand Creek Road and stay right on North River Road. Follow this road until you enter the Chester Wetlands and then travel to the end of the road until vou reach the Chester Dam and property is iust north of the dam. Access Point #2: Take the Sand Creek Road heading north and travel approximately 3 miles until you reach the western property. Access points are located along the Sand Creek Road.



A property owner may revoke permission at any time.

All persons must have written permission or other lawful form of permission to enter or remain on private land to shoot any weapon or hunt, fish, trap or retrieve game.

A person should know land is private and they are not allowed without permission because:

- The property is associated with a residence or business;
- OR cultivated:
- OR fenced or enclosed in a way that delineates the private property;
- OR unfenced and uncultivated, but is posted with conspicuous "no trespassing' signs or bright orange/ fluorescent paint at all property corners and boundaries where the property intersects navigable streams, roads, gates and rights-ofway entering the land and posted in a way that people can see the postings.

Note – if private property adjoins or is contained within public lands, the fence line adjacent to public land should be posted with "no trespassing signs" or bright orange/ fluorescent paint at the corners of the fence adjoining public land and at all navigable streams, roads, gates and rights-of-way entering the private land from public land and posted in a way that people can see the postings.

It is illegal for anyone to post public land that is not held under an exclusive control lease.

Private posting at navigable streams shall not prohibit access to navigable streams below the high-water mark as allowed by Idaho law.

A property owner may revoke permission at any time. Any person must leave private property when asked to do so by the owner or agent.

A first conviction of trespass on private property carries a mandatory one-year revocation of hunting/fishing/trapping licenses in addition to misdemeanor fine and seizure of animals taken on private property.

Federal law prohibits unauthorized trespass on Indian-owned reservation lands for hunting, fishing, or trapping purposes.
