## **Background:**

A biennial report on status of moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goats and a list of issues and preliminary proposals being considered is presented in November preceding adoption of harvest regulations in January of each odd-numbered year. In January 2023 the Fish and Game Commission will set seasons for moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goats for the 2023 and 2024 hunting seasons.

# **Statutory Authority and/or Policy Issues:**

The Idaho Fish and Game Commission administers state wildlife policy through supervision and management of the Department (Idaho Code 36-104).

## **Public Involvement Process:**

Public input is received year-round through contacts with interested sportsmen and others members of the public. Proposals and additional information will be developed and circulated statewide for public review during December-January. Public input will be summarized and considered to guide development of the Department's recommendations to the Commission in January.

#### **Justification:**

This agenda item is intended to inform Commissioners of current status, statewide management issues, and anticipated proposals for moose, bighorn sheep, and mountain goats for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.
