COHO SALMON FISHERY PROPOSAL SEPTEMBER 1, 2021

I. SEASONS – COHO SALMON

A. OPEN DATES AND BOUNDARIES

Fishing for Coho Salmon will open September 3 in the following area:

• Snake River from the Idaho/Washington border upstream to Hells Canyon Dam.

B. CLOSING DATE

The Snake River will close to fishing for Coho Salmon at midnight October 31, 2021, or may close earlier by emergency order of the Director.

C. FISHING DAYS

Fishing for Coho Salmon will be open 7 days/week.

II. LIMITS

A. DAILY AND POSSESSION LIMITS

- **Daily** = Two (2) Adult Coho Salmon, no limit on Jack Coho Salmon.
- **Possession** = Six (6) Adult Coho Salmon.

B. SEASON LIMIT

There is no Season Limit on Coho Salmon.

C. DEFINITIONS PERTAINING TO LIMITS

- <u>Adult</u> Coho Salmon are defined as Coho Salmon greater than or equal to 20 inches in length.
- Jack Coho Salmon are defined as Coho Salmon less than 20 inches in length.

D. OTHER RULES

- Anglers may harvest Coho Salmon with or without an adipose fin.
- Anglers must cease fishing for all Coho Salmon (including Jacks) once they have retained their daily or possession limit of Adult Coho Salmon.
