Background:

On March 1, 2018 the Department transitioned its license sales system to a new third party contractor, JMT. Since that time, the new system experienced issues which led to delays in draw results, system outages, and frustrated sportsmen and women.

In response the Department and JMT have finalized the service contract amendment to shorten performance from the original expiration to 11/30/2020.

In June of 2019, a solicitation was posted in coordination with the Idaho Division of Purchasing (DOP). Since that time, the Department has been actively working with DOP to receive, evaluate, and score the proposals to replace the Licensing system in time for a go-live of December 1, 2020.

The original schedule for award of the iWILD contract was by the end of October. This update will inform the Commission on the progress made to that effort.

Statutory Authority and/or Policy Issues:

I.C. 36-301 (a) 1. gives the Commission the authority to prescribe by rule the procedures for issuance of licenses and applications by a computerized licensing system.

Also, SB 1344 revised provisions of Idaho Code to have an independent entity carry out drawings for tags for controlled hunts as established by the Commission, and require IDFG to solicit bids for the contract pursuant to Idaho Code. This RFP includes the requirement to provide a draw module and complies with SB 1344.
