Game Season Setting Preview

Background:

Staff will present a statewide overview of the status of deer and elk populations. Staff will review final harvest estimates from 2021, results of aerial surveys from winter 2022, overwinter fawn survival from 2022, fall 2022 check station results, and December 2022 aerial composition survey data. Staff will also review deer and elk surveys planned for this winter, deer and elk survival monitoring, and update the Commission on the status of the elk plan process.

Staff will preview the upcoming big game season setting process and discuss public outreach plans and timelines leading up to the March commission meeting.
