**REPORT**

**Update About Agency Actions on Covid-19**

Director Ed Schriever provided an update to the Commission.

Covid-19 is a fast moving issue in Idaho and reporting its first fatality today. Some counties are being harder hit than others. The Director is in close communication with the Governor's office. There is a statewide order from Governor Little for all individuals living in Idaho to stay at home to slow the spread of COVID-19.

Consistent with the state order, IDFG is continuing certain essential functions where employees will still leave their homes to report to work, such as hatcheries, law enforcement, minimal office staffing, and specific field activities. We are implementing measures to reduce risks for those employees.

Over the past week, Regional and HQ management and staff assessed essential functions and priority tasks. IDFG travel will be limited to support only those functions and tasks.

We are taking steps to keep the rest of our staff working from home as productively as possible for the agency, and to support appropriate leave when health, care needs for household members, or other unique circumstances prevent our employees from working their full schedule. We will be deferring some activities to a later time.

Our Regional Offices (ROs) will continue to operate with limited public interaction and minimal staffing identified by Regional Supervisors. Our lobbies will be closed to walk-in traffic, and designated staff will handle certain specific requests (that can only be handled in-person) through appointment only.
