This workshop is designed for teaching those who are new to shooting or have a new firearm to sight in.



HIGHWAY 12: From 1/2 mile East of Myrtle, follow Cottonwood Creek Road 6.0 miles to South Tom Beall Road. At 6.5 miles the pavement turns to gravel. The range is on your right 9.3 miles from Highway 12
