- <u>Tournament Reports</u> you are required to provide a tournament report to IDFG within 30 days of the conclusion of the tournament (IDAPA 13.01.11.700.01). The report due date can be found at the top of your permit. Your permit email notification includes a printable report form that you must fill-in, preferably on the day of your event. Once your event has ended, enter your catch data into the online tournament report form provided to you. - Participation All participants 14 and over must have a valid fishing license.
- <u>Boat Ramps</u> When tournament anglers are using boat ramps with two or more lanes, at least one lane is required to be open for public use.
- <u>Tournament Permits</u> All boats and/or anglers are required to have a copy of this permit in their possession during the event.
- The following fish <u>cannot</u> be harvested during any tournament: wild trout (in any stream), Cutthroat Trout, White Sturgeon, Bull Trout, and Arctic Grayling.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Additional permits (Special Use or Marine Event) may be required on the body of water this event is being held. Check with the local County Sheriff or water management entity prior to the day of the event.
- Idaho law requires all boats, including those from out of state, must display a valid Idaho Invasive Species Sticker. All anglers recently fishing out of state must have their boats inspected at a Watercraft Inspection Station before launching in Idaho. New law in 2024; All water inside a vessel must be drained prior to transport including live wells. (Title 22 Chapter 1905A)
