

DEPREDATION HUNT INFO AND APPLICATION

Special controlled hunts are sometimes used to relieve big game damage problems on agricultural crops. If these hunts are needed, they will be held on short notice, involve small areas, and be limited to a few hunters.

How Can I Participate?

If you are an **Idaho resident**, with a valid hunting or combination license, fill out the form below and mail it to the regional office in the area(s) you are willing to hunt. You, and a partner if you like, may apply in different regions for deer, elk, pronghorn, black bear and turkey, but only once a year for each species. (You may photocopy these forms if necessary.) Applying for the same species in more than one region will result in disqualification from all regions.

All applications received May 1 to June 30 will be placed in random order. All applications received after June 30 will be placed at the end of the list in the order received. The list will be valid from July 1 to the following June 30.

What Are My Chances of Drawing A Depredation?

Most regions issue only a handful of depredation permits each year. If a controlled antlerless or doe/fawn hunt is open or about to open in the depredation area, holders of those permits will be given the first option to participate in the depredation hunt. After antlerless or doe/fawn controlled hunts have ended, participants will be selected in order from the depredation hunt list. Generally, applications received after June 30 have little chance of being selected.
