DIRECTIONS: From Sandpoint, US 95 N; E on ID 200 toward Hope; many pull-outs for viewing; continue S on ID 200 to view Denton Slough.

Denton Slough is a Western Grebe nesting area with courtship displays in June. Summer waterbirds also include Double-crested Cormorant, Great Blue Heron, and Black Tern. Thousands of waterfowl (American Wigeon, Redhead, Lesser Scaup, Green-winged Teal, and Tundra Swan) use Denton Slough during migration. A reliable location for Eurasian Wigeons in (especially) fall and spring.
