**DIRECTIONS:** *S of Sandpoint, turn E off US 95 between mp 466- 465 onto E Dufort Rd; go 2.6 mi; park at "Pend Oreille Wildlife Management Area; Westmond Segment."*

Although small in size, Westmond Lake provides nesting habitat for Black Terns. Nesting waterfowl, Soras, and Virginia Rails also present. This site is also a migration spot for waterfowl and shorebirds (Western Sandpiper, Long-billed Dowitcher, Greater Yellowlegs, Killdeer, and Spotted Sandpiper).
