Large number of gulls (California, Ring-billed, Herring) and waterfowl (Ring-necked Duck, Common Goldeneye, Bufflehead, Common Merganser) can be seen during the winter. Pygmy Nuthatch, Brown Creeper, Townsend's Solitaire, and Townsend's and MacGillivray's Warblers can be found during spring/summer.

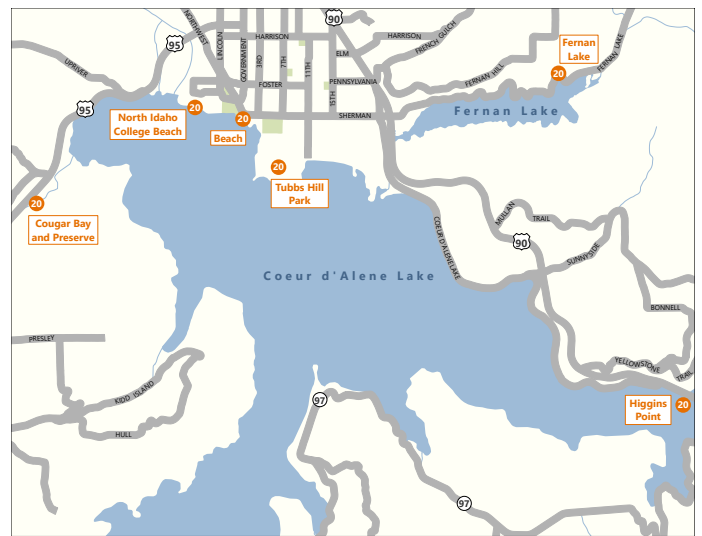
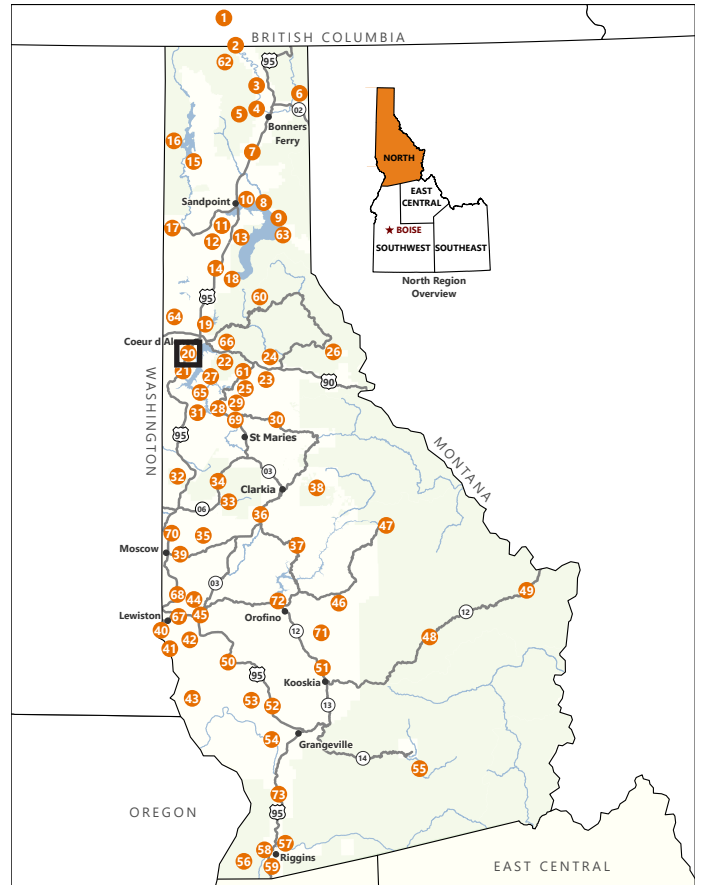
