DIRECTIONS: From Coeur d'Alene go S ~8.2 mi on Hwy 95 to mp 421.4, turn E onto Putnam Rd; Directions to the bay are prominent on the hwy; after 0.6 mi R onto S Tall Pine Rd; at the junction with Loffs Bay Rd, 2 choices: (1) travel E to Mica Bay Sportsman's Access or (2) S onto Loffs Bay Rd; as you round the bay and start up a hill, park at a pull-out and hike 100 yds to viewing platform.

Nesting Bald Eagle and Osprey. Bullock's Oriole nest in cottonwoods on both Putnam Road and Loffs Bay Road Red-eyed Vireos nest on Loffs Bay. Northern Shrike in fall and winter. Grebes, loons, wigeon, Bufflehead, and Wood Ducks are among various waterfowl. Red-necked Grebe are present all year and breed in summer. American Redstart are in the cottonwoods off Loffs Bay Road in June/July. Pygmy Nuthatch are found in the Ponderosa pine stands.
