DIRECTIONS: The Coeur d'Alene River WMA extends from the mouth of the Coeur d'Alene River at Harrison upstream to Cataldo, a distance of 25 mi; From Cataldo: county rds border the WMA; From Rose Lake: ID 3 follows the boundary of the WMA until near Black Lake. The hwy turns S toward the Round Lake segment of the WMA.

Ruffed Grouse, Common Snipe, American Coots, Wild Turkeys, Northern Harriers, American Kestrels, Virginia Rails, Sora, and Belted Kingfishers are common. Over 50 pairs of Osprey nest on the lower Coeur d'Alene River, and an additional 30 pairs nest near the mouth of the St. Joe River.
