DIRECTIONS: *From Sandpoint, US 95 N ~1.5 mi to ID 200; E on ID 200 for ~21.5 mi; R onto Driftwood Yard Rd.*

One of the more overlooked good to very good birding spots in the region worth a visit at any season. Waterbirds present almost year round with large number and variety possible in spring and fall migration. Look for Double-crested Cormorants, loons and grebes, and large number of American Coots, ducks, and shorebirds in fall. Fall migration highlights also include American Pipits, a variety of sparrows, and possibility of Lapland Longspurs and Gray-crowned Rosy-Finches.
