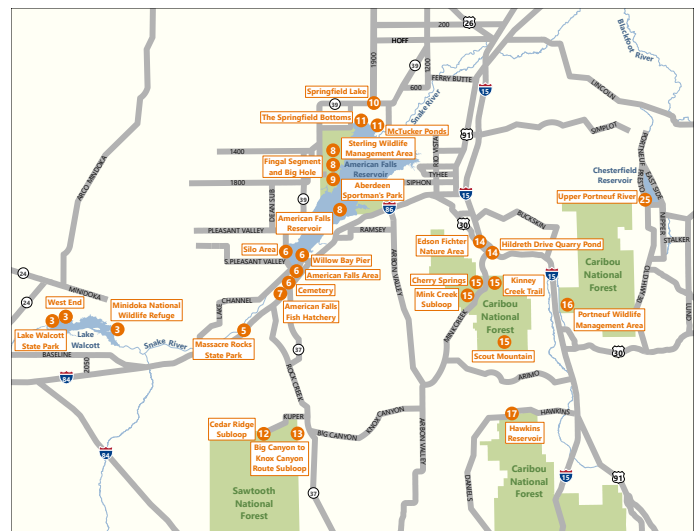
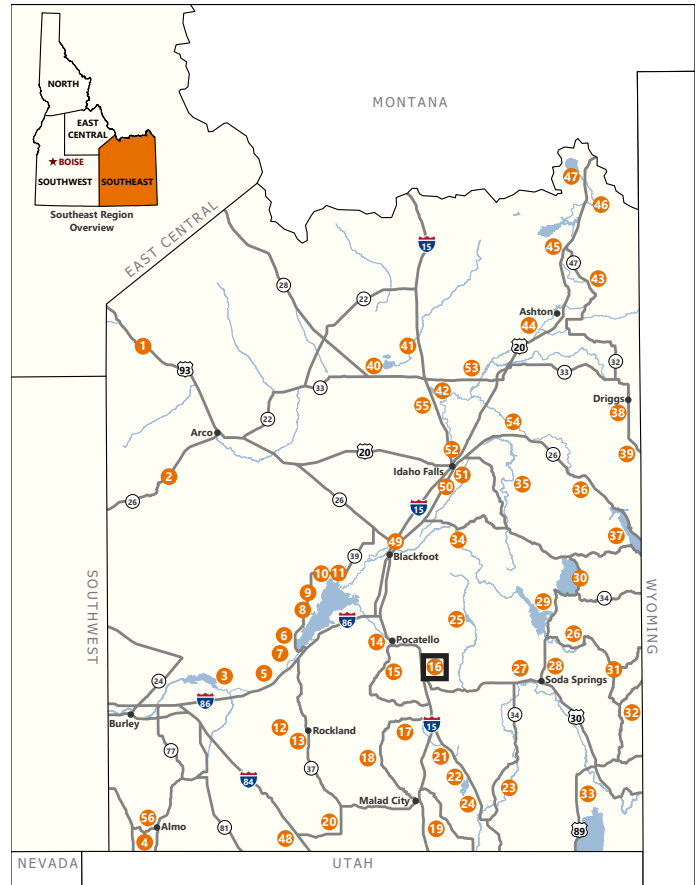

DIRECTIONS: I-15 Exit #47; take US 30 E; zero your odometer at the Chevron station; mi 0.5 turn L (N) on Old US 91; mi 3.8 turn R into parking corral.

Sharp-tailed Grouse can be found on “benches”, and watch for Red-tailed Hawks. Look for Green-tailed Towhees nesting in sagebrush habitat. The riparian habitat is likely to have nesting Yellow Warblers. MacGillivray’s and Wilson’s Warblers can be seen during migration. Golden Eagles, Northern Harriers, Red-tailed Hawks and Great Horned Owls are commonly seen as well as Dusky, Ruffed and breeding Columbian Sharp-tailed Grouse.
