## Teton Pass Subloop (Mike Harris Campground)

LAT/LONG: 43.558729,-111.068697

DIRECTIONS: From US 26 at Swan Valley, go N on ID 31 for 20.5 mi toward Victor/Driggs; at intersection of ID 31 and ID 33 (in downtown Victor), turn R onto ID 33; go towards WY for 3.9 mi to the Mike Harris Campground, which is on the R.

Mike Harris Campground is a USFS operated campground surrounded by access to the Caribou-Targhee National Forest. Present on the Forest are many conifer associates including Mountain Chickadee, Evening Grosbeak, Cassin's Finch, both crossbill species, and Pine Siskin. American Dipper is easily found along Mike Harris Creek and in the riparian corridors of the creek, Black-headed Grosbeak, Calliope Hummingbird, Swainson's Thrush, and Fox Sparrow can be seen.
