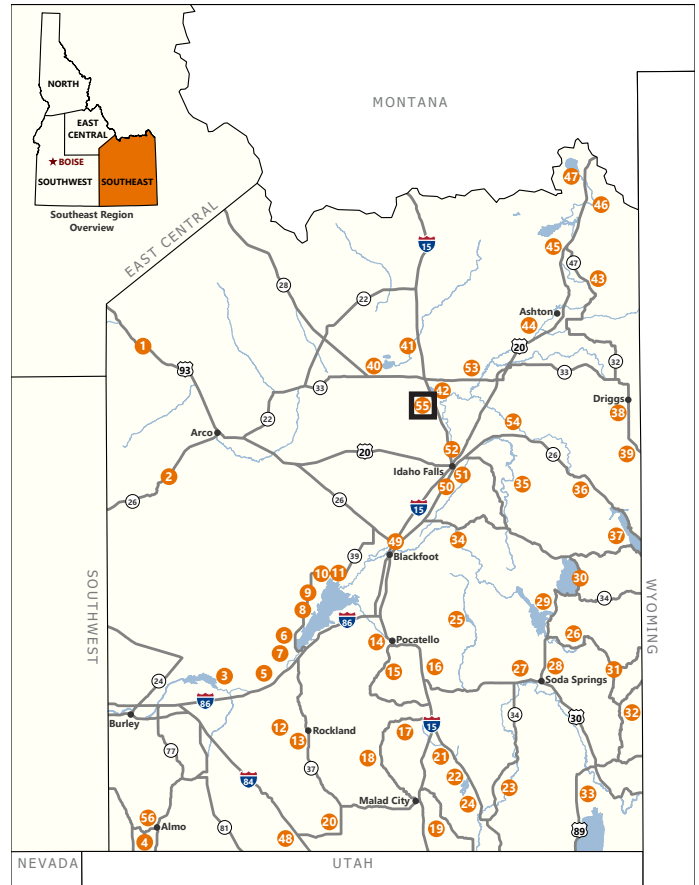

DIRECTIONS: From Idaho Falls, I-15 N for ~15 mi to ID 48/N Berrett Rd, Exit #135; get off at exit and turn L onto ID 48/N Berrett Rd; then R onto Lowell Moore Rd for 1.9 mi; R onto N 2700 E for 1 mi; R onto E 800 N/Diamond Rd for 0.5 mi; pond on L.

Western Wings Pond is a property recently acquired by IDFG as an addition to the Market Lake WMA. It has excellent waterfowl watching during spring and fall migration with mergansers, grebes, goldeneye, scaup, and other divers found in good numbers. Black Tern and American Pipit have been reported as spring migrants at the pond and Yellow-headed Blackbird, Wilson's Snipe, and Western Kingbird are local breeders. Shorebirds can be present during migration, if habitat is available.
