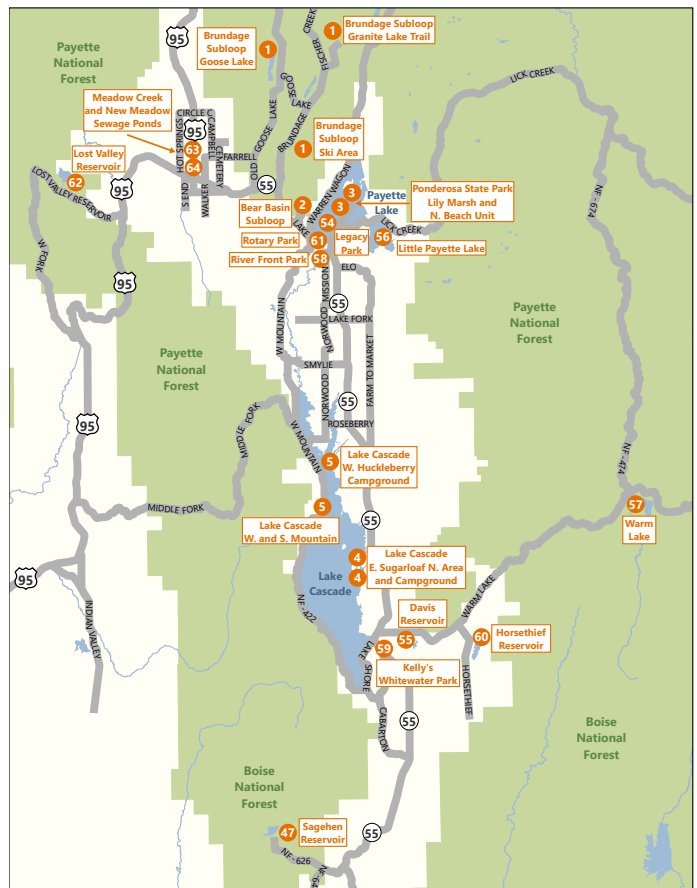
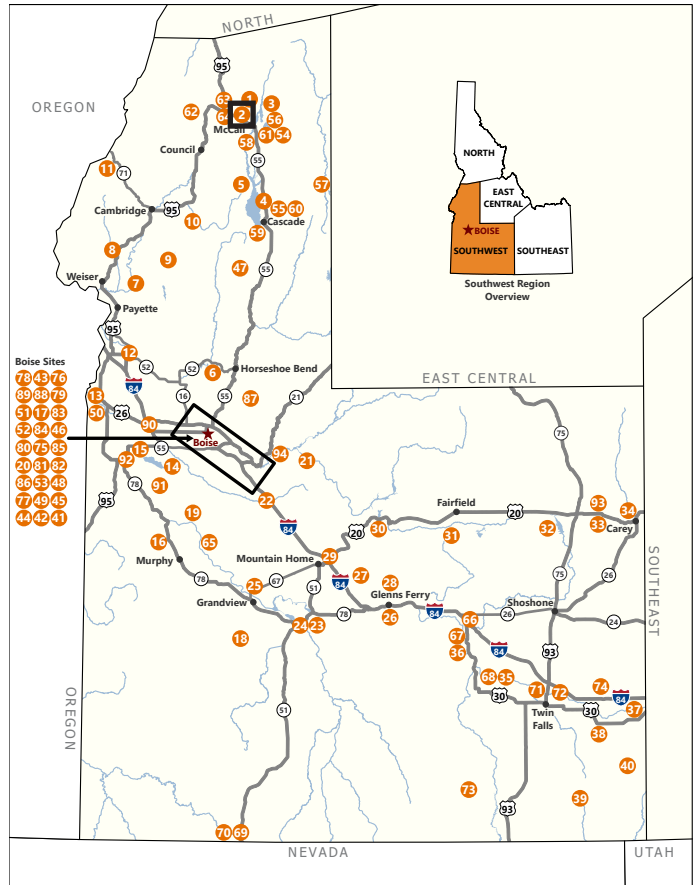

LAT/LONG: 44.9423898,-116.1384683

**DIRECTIONS:** From McCall, ID 55 W ~2.5 mi; R (N) at mp 146.6 onto FR 451 (Bear Basin Rd); zero odometer at mi 0.8 stay R (straight) and enter FS land; mi 1.3 park at pull-out on L (W); walk old rd to explore meadow; continue N on FR 451.

Driving access is limited to snow-free months (generally May-Nov.) Look for high numbers of nesting Dark-eyed Junco, Downy, Hairy, and Pileated Woodpeckers, Western Tanager, Swainson's and Hermit Thrushes, Red-tailed Hawk, Mountain Bluebird, and Wilson's Snipe. Highlights of this area include Williamson's Sapsucker and Great Gray Owl.
