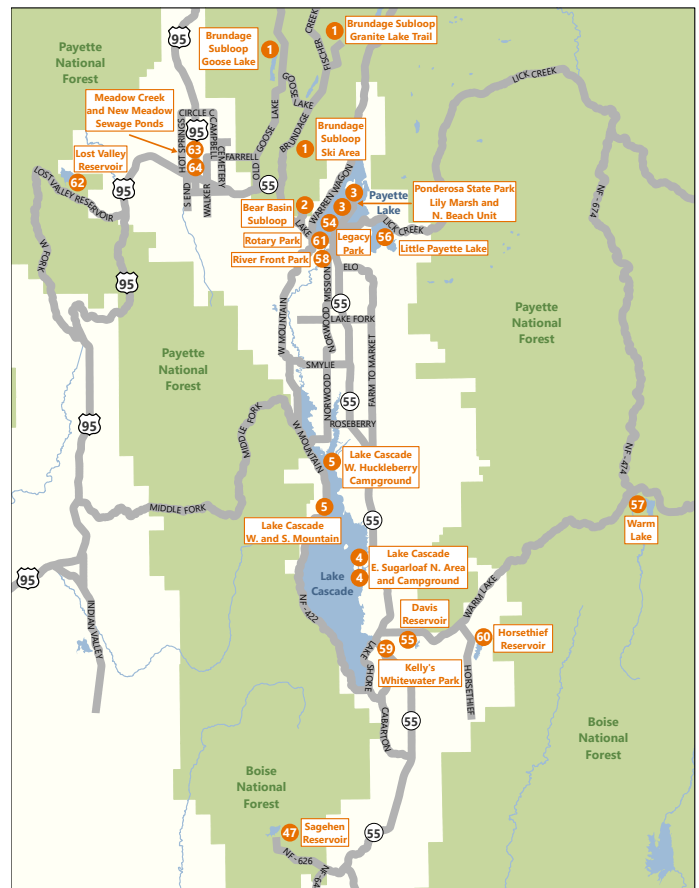
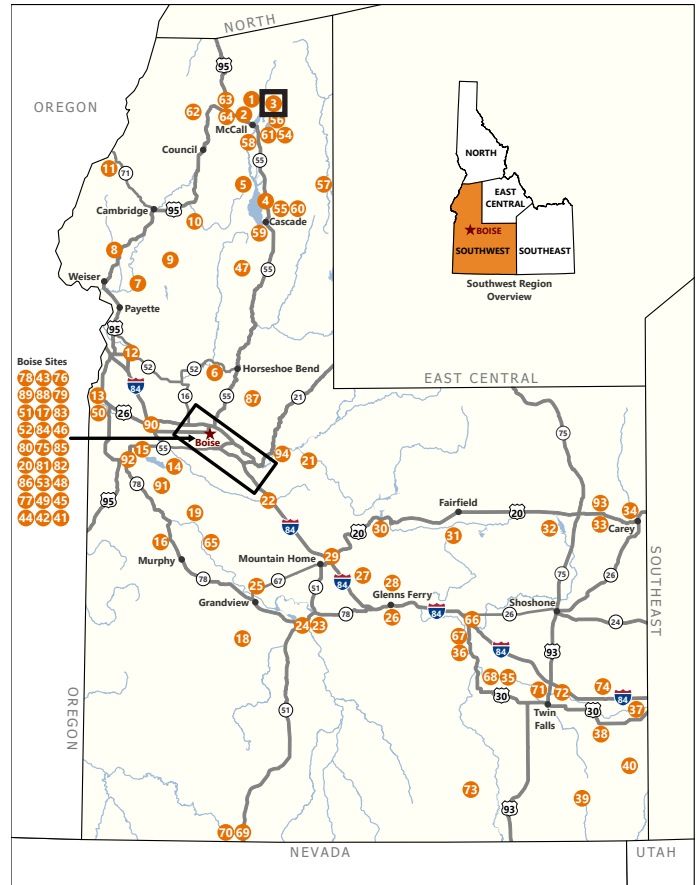

**DIRECTIONS:** Signs to the park are posted at every major intersection in McCall. From ID 55 in McCall (3rd St), turn E onto Railroad Ave; rd will curve R and change name to Wooley Ave; at second 4-way stop turn L onto Davis St and continue straight to park entrance in another 1.3 mi.

Look for American Three-toed Woodpecker. Likely species to be seen are Barred Owl, Pileated Woodpecker, Osprey, Great Blue Heron, Swainson's Thrush, Townsend's Warbler, Western Tanager, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Vaux's Swift, Olive-sided Flycatcher, and Willow Flycatcher. In winter, look for Great Gray Owl, Pine Siskin, woodpeckers, and chickadees, and nuthatches.
