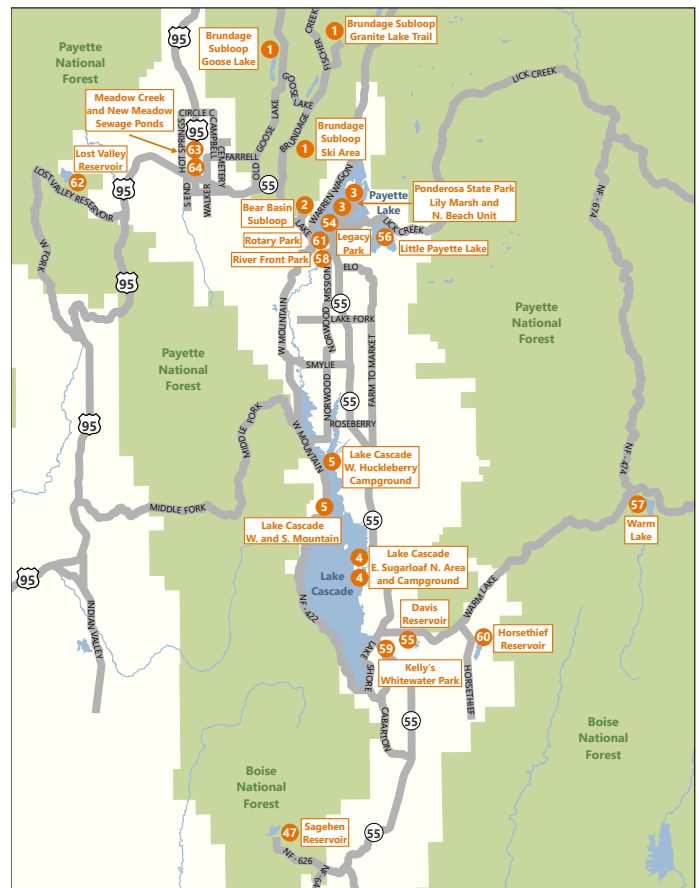
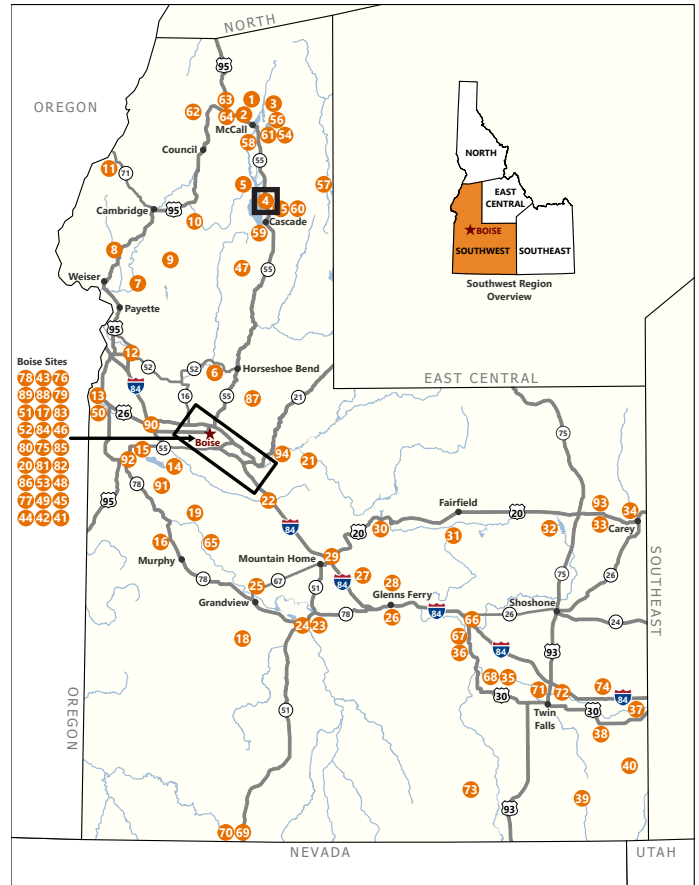

DIRECTIONS: From Cascade, N on ID 55 for ~6 mi; L onto Stonebreaker and follow to end.

Mudflats around the reservoir are good for viewing migrating shorebirds and waterfowl. Birds that can be seen include Bald Eagle, Osprey, Swainson's and Rough-legged Hawks, Tundra and Trumpeter Swans, American White Pelican, Western and Pied-billed Grebes, Sora, Virginia Rail, Marsh Wren, and Snow and Ross's Geese.
