DIRECTIONS: I-84 Exit #26; W on US 20/26 to Parma; continue W for 3.5 mi; at "Sportsman's Access" sign turn L (W) on Old Fort Boise Rd; travel 2 mi to WMA.

Idaho's most dependable location for thousands of Snow and Greater White-fronted Geese during spring. Common nesters include Cinnamon and Blue-winged Teal and Red-tailed and Swainson's Hawks. Large Great Blue Heron and Double-crested Cormorant rookery at the west end. Areas adjacent to the Snake River are open year-round.
