DIRECTIONS: *From Mountain Home, US 51 S for 15 mi; cross Snake River; L at mp 76.6 onto ID 78; travel 1.7 mi and turn R; follow rd to park.*

This state park boasts the tallest single-structured sand dune in North America, at 470 feet tall. The dunes are intermixed with sagebrush desert and grassland flats. There are trails around two shallow, marshy lakes lined with riparian shrubs and trees where birds are abundant during migration.
