DIRECTIONS: *From Mountain Home, US 20 NE for 23 mi; L (N) at mp 118 onto FR 160 (Camas Reservoir Rd); 2.4 mi to dam.*

Look for Gadwall, Cinnamon Teal, Northern Shoveler, Northern Pintail, Ring-necked Duck, Greater Sage-Grouse, Eared, Western and Clark's Grebes, and Sandhill Crane (breed in the area). White-faced Ibis can be found during the spring. Turkey Vulture, Osprey, Bald and Golden Eagles, Northern Harrier, Red-tailed Hawk, American Kestrel, Prairie Falcon, American Coot, and American White Pelican in the fall. Sage Thrasher, Common Nighthawk, Northern Flicker, and other woodpeckers are present.
