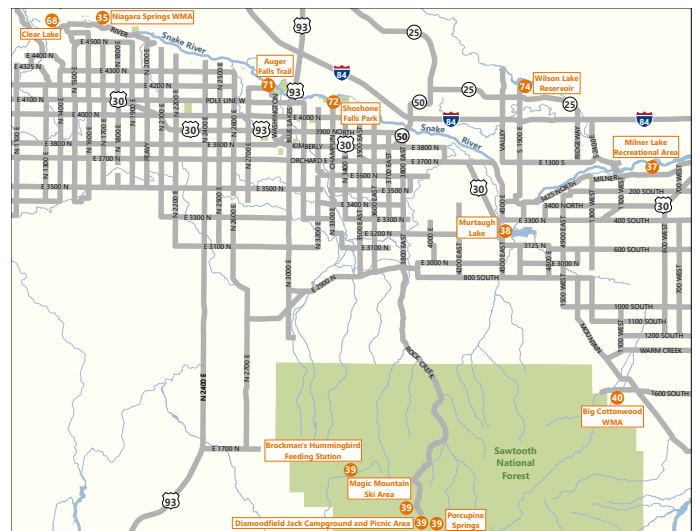
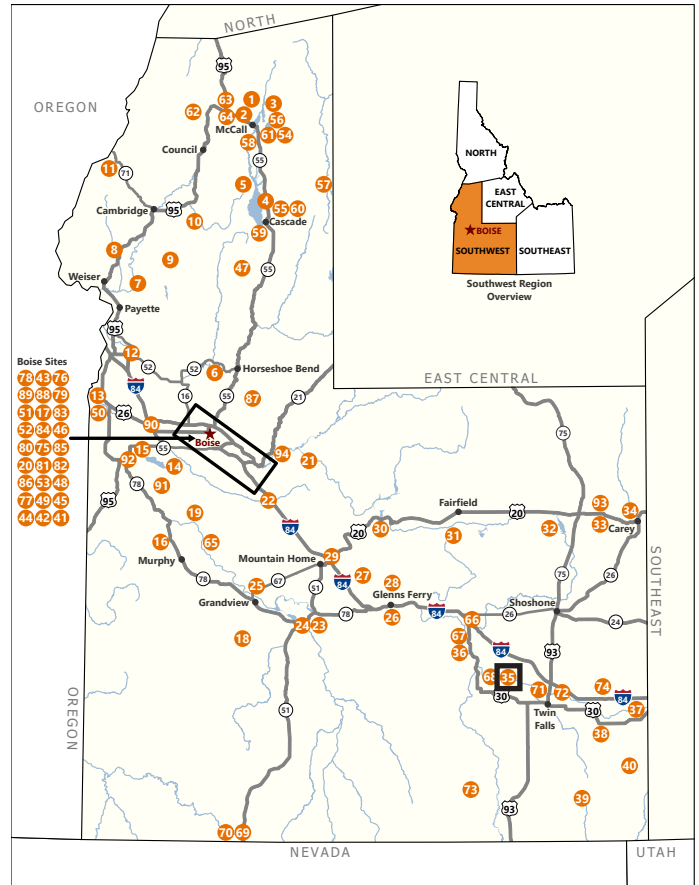

DIRECTIONS: *East entrance: I-84 Exit #157; zero odometer; S on Rex Leland Hwy (Orchard Valley Rd/1950 E); at 6.5 mi rd veers L (E) and descends into gorge; R (S) into WMA's entrance at mi 7; West entrance: I-84 Exit 157, zero odometer: S on Rex Leland Hwy (Orchard Valley Rd/1950 E); at 5 mi turn R (W) onto 3500 S (Bob Barton Rd); drive 2.5 mi to where rd turns south onto Clear Lakes Rd/Clear Lakes Grade (1700E) for 1.5 mi. Turn L (E) into parking lot at the base of the grade.*

Over 5,000 ducks winter along this portion of the Snake River annually. Look for wintering sparrow flocks which may have rare Harris's, White-throated, or possibly a very rare Golden-crowned Sparrow. A great place for owls in early spring; Northern Saw-whet, Western Screech-, Barn, and Great Horned can be reliably found in late Feb. - March. Spring nesting waterfowl include Green-winged and Cinnamon Teal, and Wood Ducks. A viewing blind allows a more intimate viewing opportunity.
