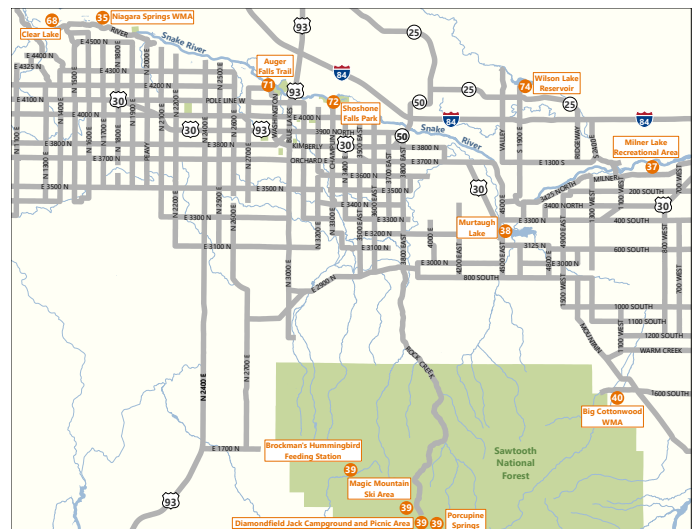
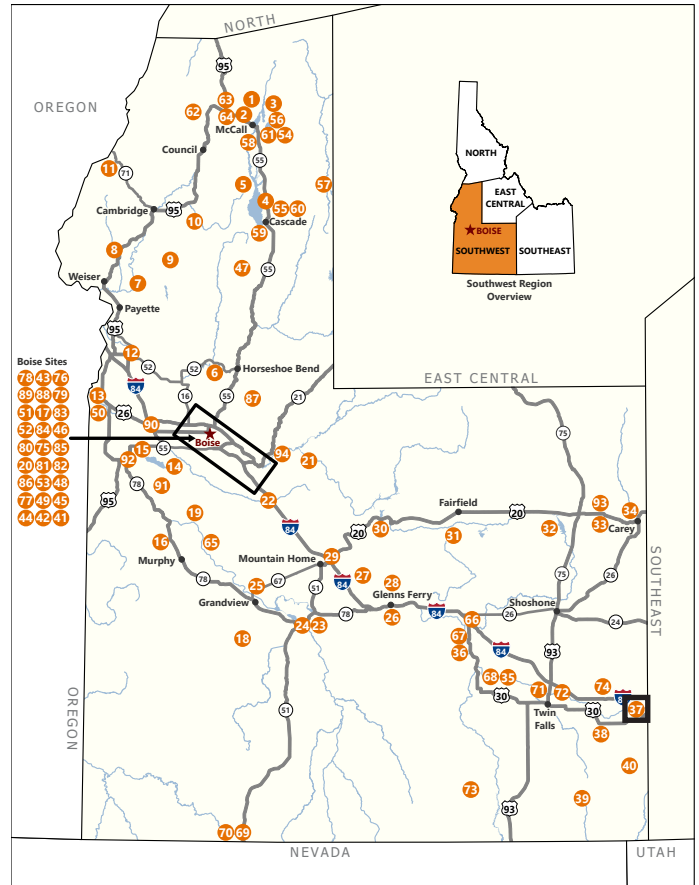

DIRECTIONS: From Burley, at junction of US 30/ID 27, US 30 W for 7.7 mi; R (N) at "Milner Historic/Recreation" sign (Burley Trap Club) for 1.5 mi; L (W) for 3.2 mi on gravel rd to parking area.

American White Pelican in spring and summer and occasionally Bald Eagle in winter can be seen. Migration periods are best for seeing Gadwall, Green-winged and Cinnamon Teal, Ruddy Duck, American Wigeon, and Western Meadowlark. Good place for gulls and grebes in fall and spring.
