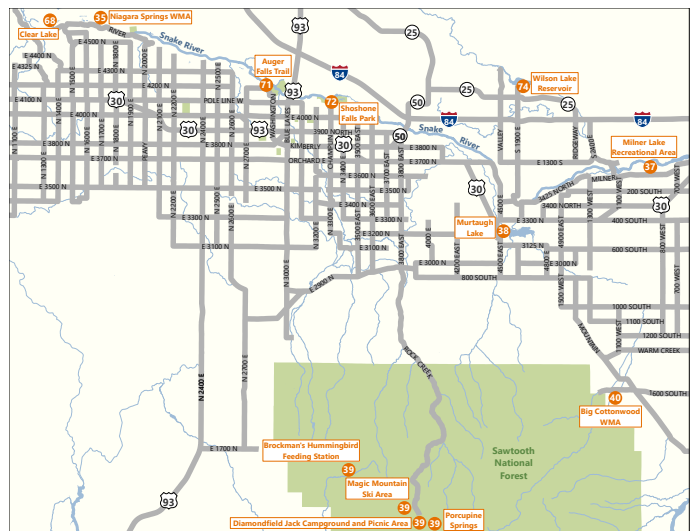
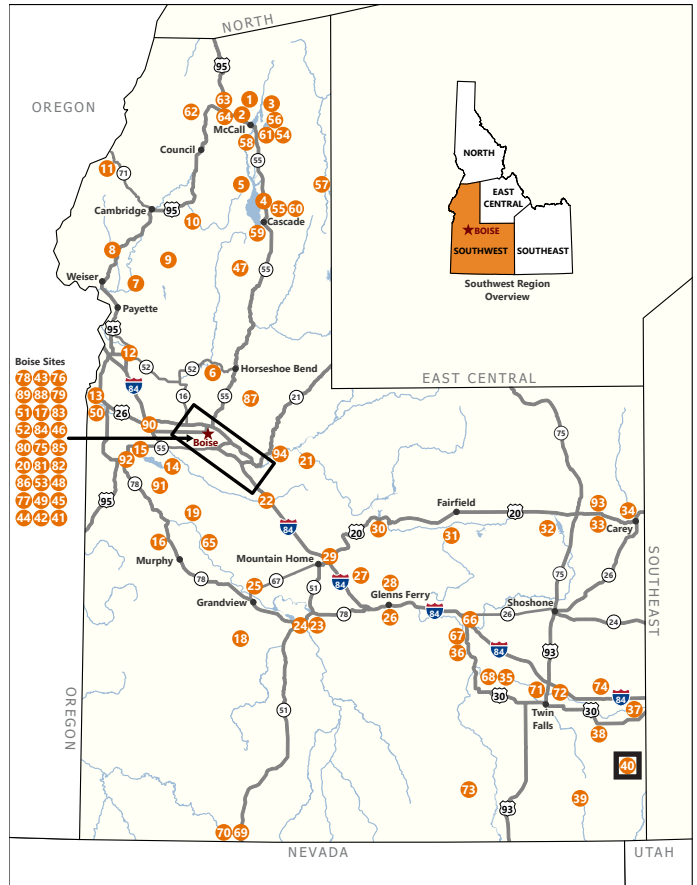

A premier place to see Idaho's juniper country birds: Juniper Titmouse, Plumbeous Vireo, Woodhouse's Scrub-Jay, Bushtit, Gray Flycatcher, and Ash-throated Flycatcher. A fantastic place for riparian birds. The WMA hosts a rare sight in south-central Idaho: its own Wild Turkey population.
