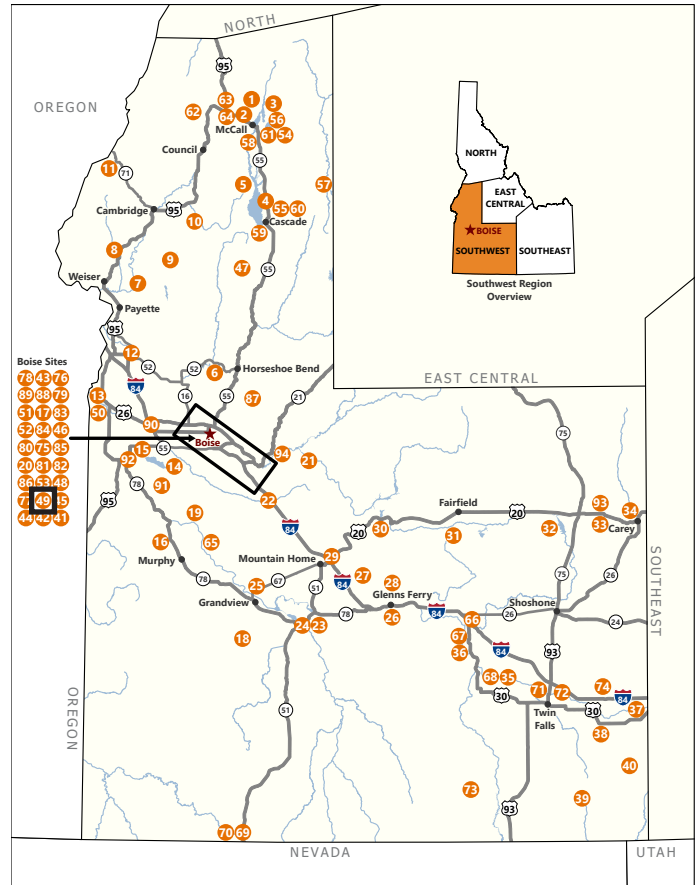

DIRECTIONS: In east Boise, from the intersection of Warm Springs Ave and ID 21, cross over ID 21 to the dirt rd and follow to the parking area.

This site has excellent birding year round. In winter, look for mixed flocks full of Golden-crowned and Ruby-crowned Kinglets, chickadees, and Brown Creepers. Keep your eyes open for Lincoln's Sparrows among the juncos, Song Sparrows, and White-crowned Sparrows. Along the river look for goldeneyes, mergansers, and the occasional American Dipper. In spring through fall, look for House Wrens, Black-capped Chickadees, Bullock's Orioles, and Yellow Warblers. Specialties include Gray Catbird, Bewick's Wren, and Yellow-breasted Chat.
