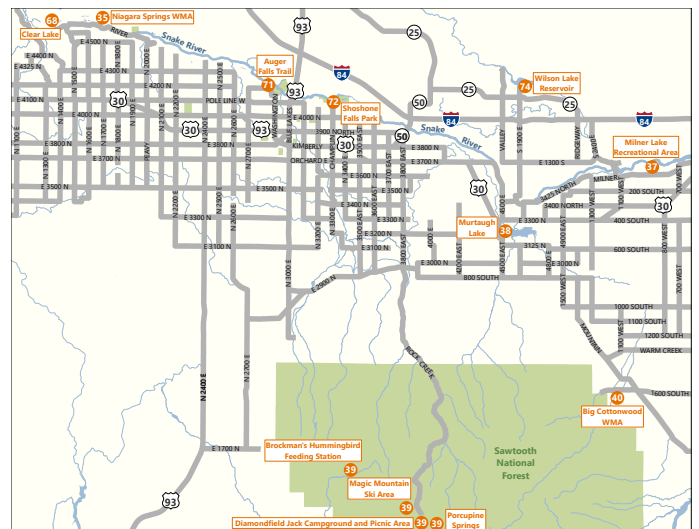
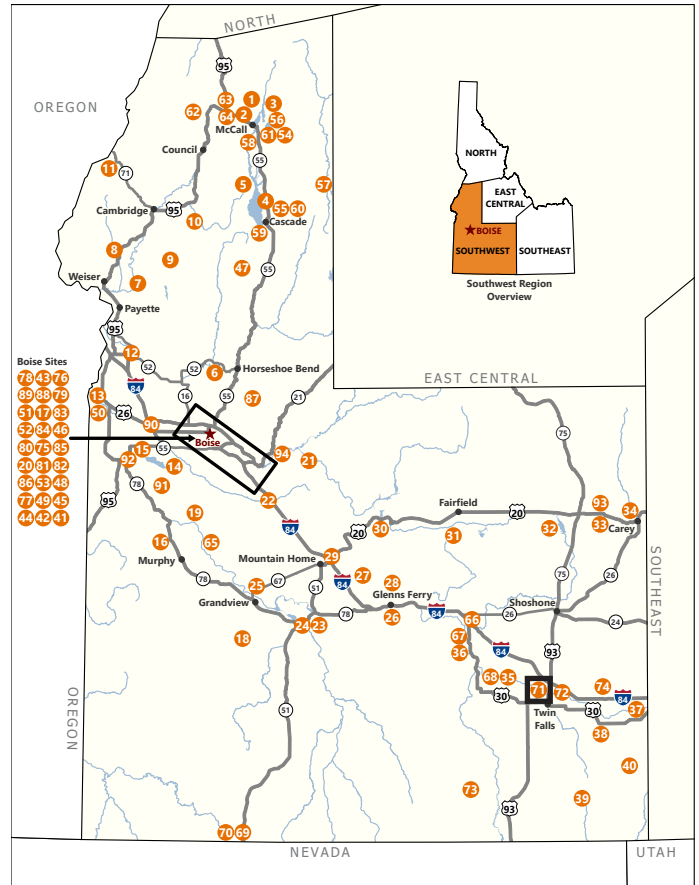

**DIRECTIONS:** From Twin Falls, W on Canyon Springs Rd and follow past golf course and waste water treatment plant to trailhead parking lot.

Look for Sora, Virginia Rail, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, numerous raptor species and swallows, Yellow-breasted Chat, Lazuli Bunting, Bullock's Oriole, Black-headed Grosbeak, and Canyon, Rock, House, and Marsh Wrens. The corridor of trees and shrubs lining the entry road can be good for migrating warblers. Very reliable place to find Bushtit.
