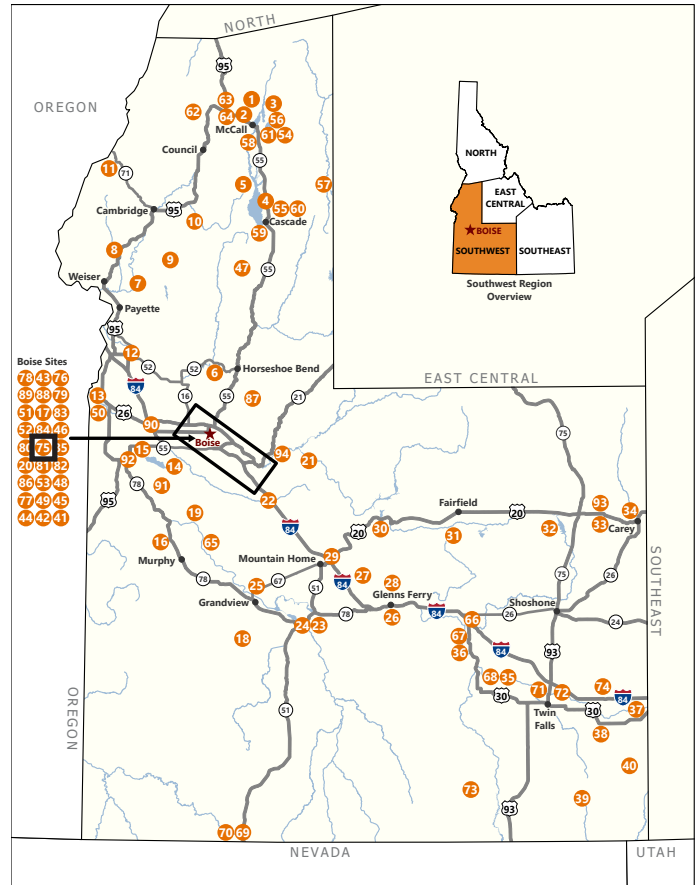

At the interface of the city and the foothills, on the north side of Boise; nesting Bank Swallows as well as a pair of nesting Great Horned Owls can be found on the sandstone hills across from the Foothills Learning Center. Look for Yellow-breasted Chat, Gray Catbird, Bullock's Oriole, and Black-headed Grosbeaks during summer. Year-round birds include Bewick's Wren, Spotted Towhee, Lesser and American Goldfinch, and Downy Woodpecker.
