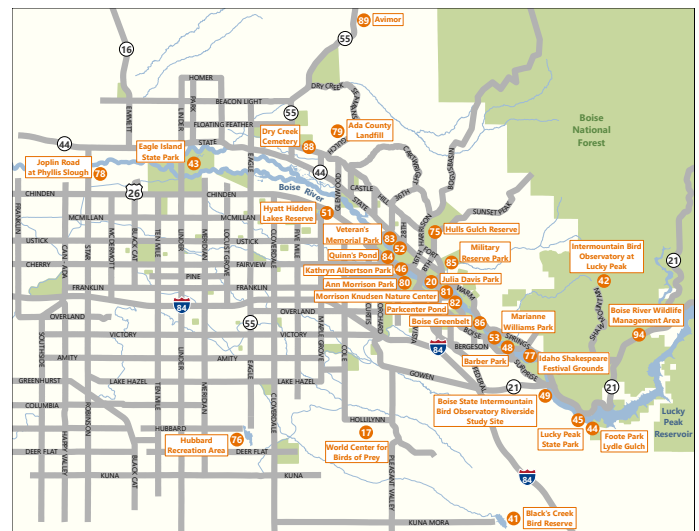
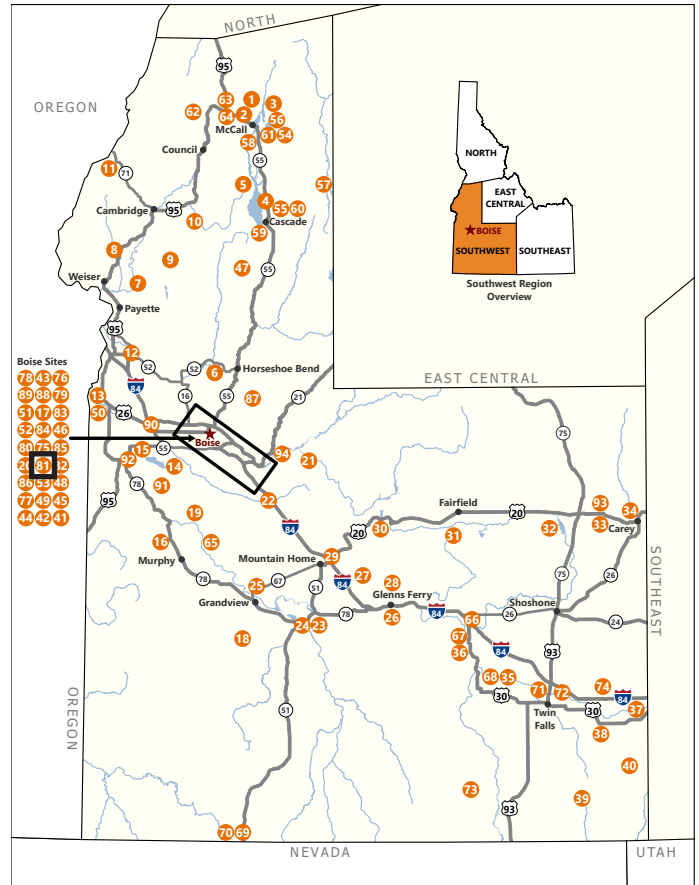

The MK Nature Center's 4.6 acres of habitat provides a surprising variety of bird life. The large pond and smaller streams regularly host Wood Duck, Great Blue Heron, and Belted Kingfisher. In winter, Ring-necked Duck and Hooded Merganser are also seen. Cooper's Hawk is the most frequently seen raptor. Migratory songbirds are a spring highlight: Western Tanager, Warbling Vireo, Western Wood-Pewee, Black-chinned Hummingbird, and MacGillivray's, Wilson's, and Yellow Warbler. Year-round residents include Downy Woodpecker, Song Sparrow, Dark-eyed Junco (in winter), Lesser and American Goldfinch, Black-capped Chickadee, Red-breasted Nuthatch, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, and Western Screech-Owl.
