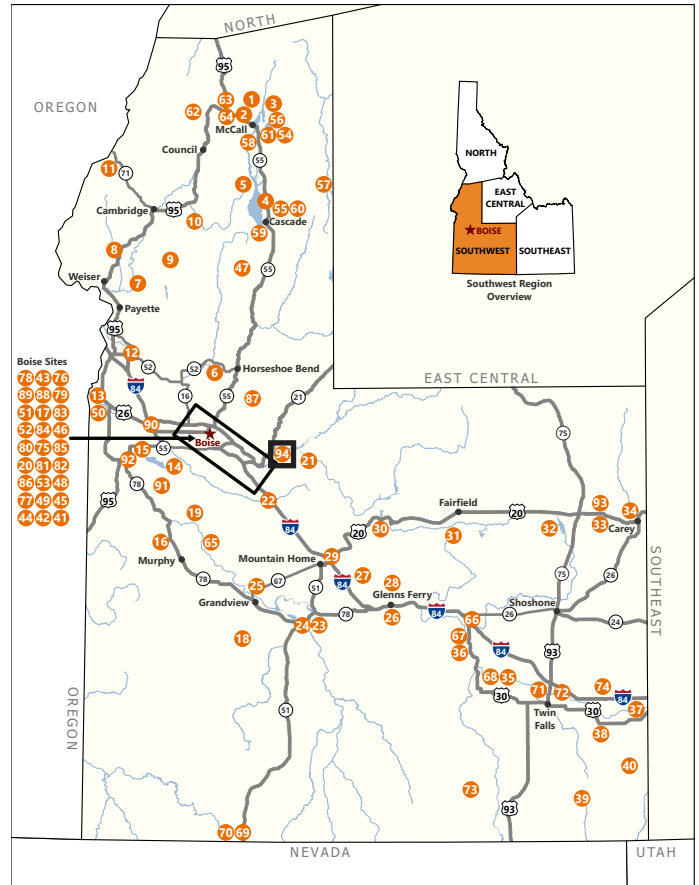

DIRECTIONS: *From the intersection of ID 21/I-84, take ID 21 N; go ~4 mi past the top of Lucky Peak Dam, passing The Hilltop Café; ~0.5 mi after the Cafe the WMA parking area will be on the L.*

The Boise River WMA is situated in the foothills of the Boise mountains and along Lucky Peak and Arrowrock Reservoirs in the Boise River drainage. Look for Golden Eagle, Red-tailed Hawk, and Turkey Vultures. Breeding birds at the WMA include Dusky Flycatcher, Western Wood-Pewee, Yellow-breasted Chat, Bullock's Oriole, and Lazuli Bunting.
