It is understood that the trials will be held under the following regulations:

1. This permit is valid for the number of trials or events listed during the same calendar year.
2. Trials shall be run only on the lands and dates specified on the second page (permits may be amended).
3. All persons carrying uncased firearms at the trial site must have a valid Idaho resident or nonresident hunting license in possession.
4. Dogs shall be under supervision of handlers at all times. Every precaution shall be taken to minimize the impact on native game birds on the area in which the trial is being held.
5. Artificially propagated game birds authorized for release must be certified as disease free under standards set forth by the National Poultry Improvement Program.
6. All wild birds taken during the trial must be returned to the nearest IDFG regional office within three days after the meet. All wild birds killed or injured seriously will be donated to a charitable institution.
7. Idaho Fish and Game Wildlife Management Areas are closed to all dog field trial activities from October 1-July 31 unless authorized by the Director.
