To purchase a nonresident Adult, Junior, or Disabled American Veteran general season deer or elk tag, please go online to **gooutdoorsidaho.com**, visit a license vendor or Fish and Game office, or call 1-800-554-8685.

A license buyer is required to pay an access/depredation annual fee when purchasing their first annual license of the year. It will not apply to any additional annual licenses purchased later in the year, nor is it required to purchase a daily license.

### **PURCHASE METHODS**

Nonresident licenses, general season tags and permits may be purchased at Fish and Game offices, over the phone, on the Internet or at any license vendor statewide. You may have a relative or friend purchase for you at a vendor if they have the identification information requested on the application.

You may add a tag for another species via credit card purchase, over the Internet or at a license vendor.

**Credit Card Purchase:** Visa, MasterCard and Discover. Dial **1-800-55HUNT5 (554-8685)**. You can also make your purchase online at **goutdoorsidaho.com**. There is an extra charge for this service. The advantage is immediate confirmation of purchase.

Mail: Fill out and mail the application, along with proper payment, to the address provided on the application. Processing of applications received in the mail begins December 1. Be sure the correct amount is submitted in check or money order. If more than one application is mailed per envelope with one check to cover them all, be sure the amount is correct. An error could result in delay or return of all the applications in the package. Personal checks accepted. If you use an outfitter, the outfitter must purchase your tags.

### **ARCHERY HUNTERS**

Idaho requires all first-time bowhunters to pass an archery education course. Experienced bowhunters are exempted. Please fill in the archery information or complete the affidavit on the application.

### THREE YEAR LICENSE

Spend less time in line and more time in the field – check out the Three-year Licenses in the Big Game Regulations or online **goutdoorsidaho.com**.

### **OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Licenses, tags and permits are not transferable. Refunds are allowed as specified in the big game rules.

Nonresident Disabled Veterans (DAV): Nonresident disabled American veterans with a disability rating of 40 percent or more by Veterans Affairs are eligible for nonresident DAV reduced fees for licenses and tags. Individuals must submit a letter from the Veterans Affairs office verifying a serviceconnected disability rating of 40 percent or greater. Such documentation may bear any date prior to license application. Documentation will be required only for the initial application and will not be required for subsequent applications.

**Migratory Bird License Validation:** Required to hunt any species managed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service as a migratory species. Data collected will provide a better basis for management of interstate/international species.

Upland Game Bird Permit: Required at all pheasant stocking program locations. See idfg.idaho.com/hunt/pheasant/stocking. Not required for under 18.

## DATES TO REMEMBER

- January 15 February 15: Application period for spring black bear controlled hunts.
- February 1 March 1: Application period for spring turkey controlled hunts.
- April 1 30: Application period for mountain goat, bighorn sheep and moose controlled hunts.
- May 1 June 5: Application period for deer, elk, pronghorn, fall black bear and fall turkey controlled hunts.

**December 1:** Nonresident licenses and general season tags available for the following year.
