The table above is compiled from data that is collected from our mandatory furtaker report from.

**Season:** A trapping season straddles portions of two calendar years. For example the 2018 season refers to the fall of 2018-to the early spring of 2019.

**Trap Nights:** This metric is calculated by multiplying the average number of sets a trapper maintains for a given species by the number of nights those traps were set. For example, if a person sets 10 traps for 10 nights for wolves, this would be 100 wolf trap nights.

**Wolves Harvested:** This represents the number of wolves reported harvested by trapping (both foothold traps and snares). Due to the structure of the furtaker report form, we are unable to determine if animals are captured in a foothold or snare.

**Non-Target Captures:** Due to the structure the furtaker report form, we are unable to determine what target animal was being pursued when a non-target animal was captured. The information above represents the number of ungulates and dogs captured by trappers that reported pursuing wolves during the corresponding trapping season. With that in mind, these non-target captures could have occurred while pursuing species other than wolves, but we are not able to make this differentiation. Alive means the animal was reported as being released alive. Mortality means the animal was found dead at the site.

Ungulates: Represents the sum of antelope, elk, moose, mule deer, and white-tailed deer for a given season.

Dogs: Represents the sum of dogs (includes those identified as feral) for a given season.
