

# BEGINNING 2021 ADULT NONRESIDENT TAGS ARE LIMITED

## Nonresident Limits and Outfitter Allocation for: General Elk, Regular Deer, and White-tailed Deer Tags

- In 2020, the Idaho Fish and Game Commission created new tag limits for 2021 nonresident, general-season deer and elk hunts to address hunter congestion concerns.
- Beginning in 2021, adult nonresident hunters are limited to 10 or 15 percent of the total hunters in each general, **uncapped elk zone or deer unit**. The nonresident limits are determined and limited by tag type within uncapped elk zones and deer units – elk A tags, elk B tags, regular deer tags, and white-tailed deer tags. Twelve backcountry deer units with low hunter participation were limited to the existing level of nonresidents.
- A portion of nonresident tags are allocated for outfitters in general hunts based on the highest outfitted use in each uncapped elk zone or deer unit in 2018 and 2019. Outfitter allocated tags are only sold to persons that have entered into a signed agreement for the services of a licensed outfitter.
- Controlled hunts and capped elk zones have existing limits on nonresident participation, as well as outfitter allocation. Both remain unaffected by this change.
- **A supplemental brochure** to the Idaho Big Game 2021 Seasons & Rules will be available spring 2021 and will include nonresident tag limits and outfitter allocation. Outfitter allocation for controlled hunts are still included in the Idaho Big Game 2021 Seasons & Rules, and both outfitter allocation and nonresident limits for capped elk zones will be included in the supplemental brochure.
