Dear Idaho Furtaker:

On the reverse side is the Mandatory Furtaker Report. Trappers are required by Idaho Law (Section 36-1105) to submit a report of their harvest. Please send these reports by July 31. Any trapper failing to make such a report shall be refused a license to trap animals for the ensuing year.

Trapping opportunities continue to be challenged, and the best defense is good information collected by this report. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO COMPLETE AND RETURN THIS MANDATORY REPORT CARD.**

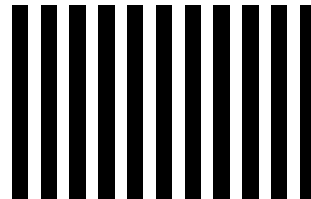
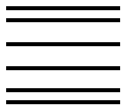
