MANDATORY FURTAKER REPORT

Dear Idaho Furtaker:

On the reverse side is the Mandatory Furtaker Report. Trappers are required by Idaho Law (Section 36-1105) to submit a report of their harvest each year by July 31. Any trapper failing to make such a report shall be refused a license to trap animals for the ensuing year.

Trapping opportunities continue to be challenged, and the best defense is good information collected by this report. PLEASE REMEMBER TO COMPLETE AND RETURN THIS MANDATORY REPORT CARD.

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
